

Camp High Hopes Opens Two New Cabins For Summer Campers

Sioux City, Iowa — June 2, 2016 - Camp High Hopes is pleased to announce the opening of Hampshire Cabin. With the completion of a new cabin, Camp High Hopes now has three main cabins on its campus – Hampshire, Berkshire & Cardinal. Hampshire and Berkshire Cabins will be used as dormitory space, while Cardinal Cabin will be utilized for programs and activities.

Our new cabins, Berkshire and Hampshire, help Camp High Hopes to continue our mission of bringing smiles to children, teens, and adults with disabilities. As the demand for our programs increases, so does the need for more space. Our new cabins will house 20 campers and 8 counselors each. Both are designed to be fully accessible to fulfill the varying needs of our campers with intellectual and physical disabilities. Berkshire opened in June 2015 and Hampshire will open in June 2016 for our sleep-over campers to enjoy.

“The addition of two new cabins means that we can provide an even greater experience for campers,” says Chris Liberto, the Executive Director of Camp High Hopes. “We’re thrilled that Hampshire and Berkshire cabins will be full this summer, and we would like to thank every donor and volunteer who helped turn artist renderings into the buildings you see today.”

We want to thank our donors and community members who made this possible, especially Missouri River Historic Development, or MRHD. Through our partnership and MRDH’s generous grant, the construction of the cabins became a reality. These buildings help to solidify Camp High Hopes’ place in the community as we welcome more campers than ever before for our summer programs.

Our summer programs ramp up next week with the arrival of more than 40 summer staff members to camp. They come from all across the world to work at camp. Campers arrive for their first summer camp sessions on June 20. Summer camp programs run through August 12. With record enrollment, many of our summer camp sessions are already full and campers are anxiously awaiting their week at camp.

Camp High Hopes offers year-round therapeutic recreation programs and respites in Sioux City, IA designed to enrich the lives of youth and adults with diagnosed disabilities. Our high quality programs include experiences in archery, canoeing, and outdoor education, amongst others, for individuals and groups with disabilities. Coming from Iowa, Nebraska, and South Dakota, campers arrive with anticipation and excitement, leaving with smiles, new friends, and fond memories for years to come.

Thanks to the support from our community, donors, parents, volunteers, and partners, we are able to continue to offer life-changing therapeutic recreation activities to the individuals who need them the most.
